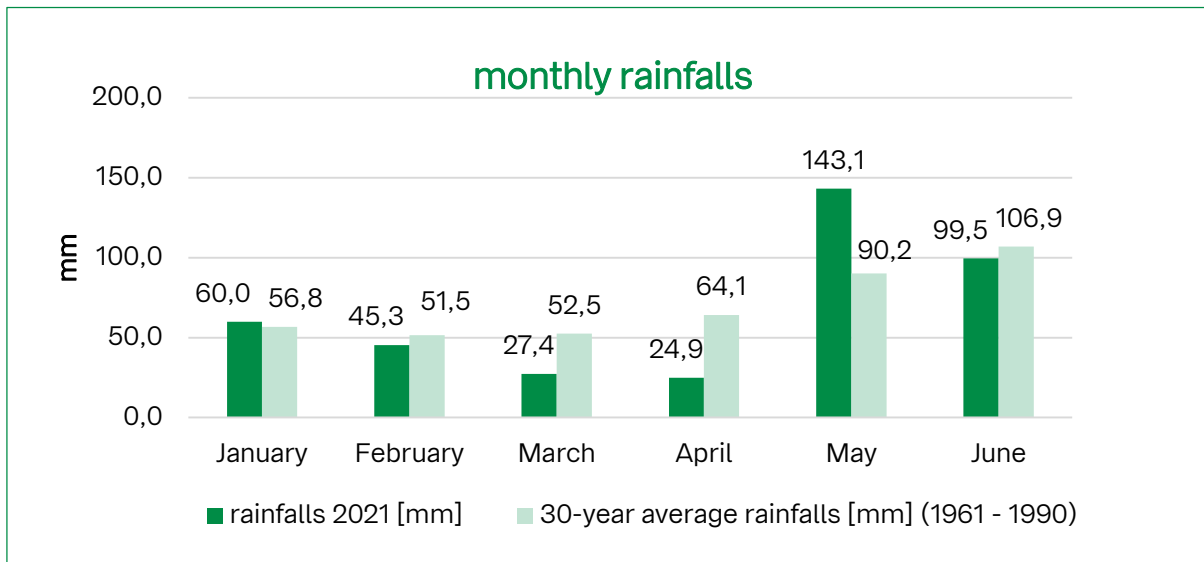
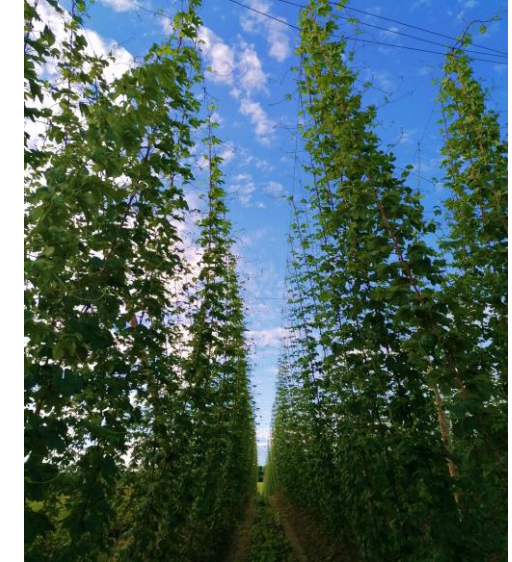
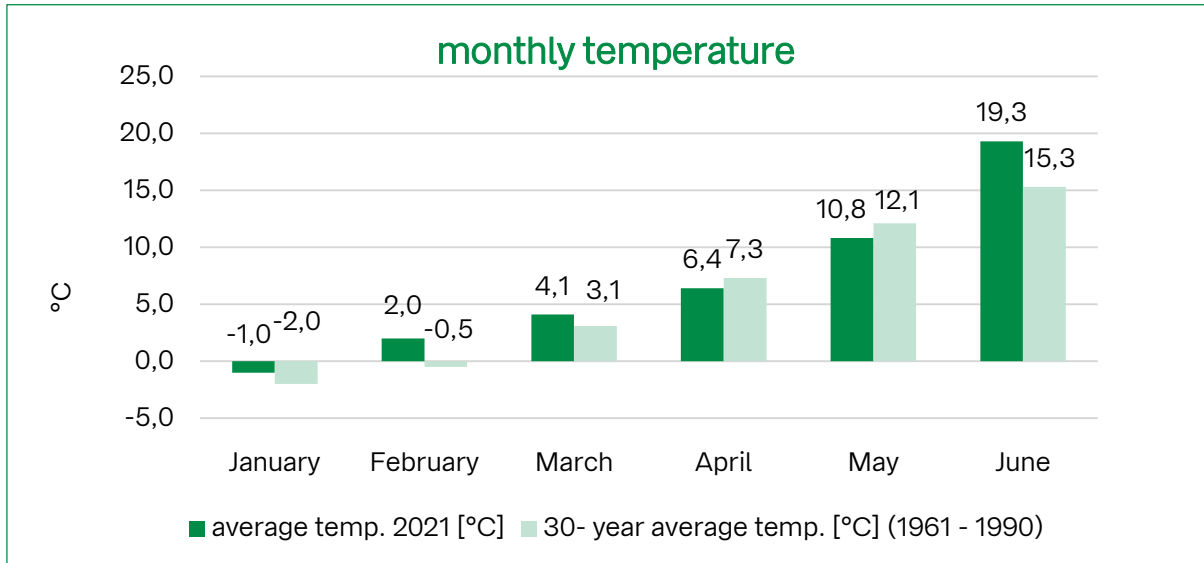


# Crop development report– Hallertau

June 2021



The high summer temperatures of the last two weeks of June have positively influenced length growth, so that most of the hops have now reached skeleton height.

Diseases such as peronospora and powdery mildew are under control.

The severe thunderstorms of the past few days delivered high rainfall, but the hops were spared hail damage.
