

## Crop development report – Tettnang May 2021







May was, like April, significant cooler than long-term average. At the same time precipitation was very high. The water reserves in the ground were thus optimally replenished for the next weeks.

The growth level of the most important aroma varieties Tettnang and Hallertau Mittelfrüh is about one week later, of the other varieties about two weeks later than average. With the announced warm temperatures a strong growth can be expected.

Despite the weeks of humid weather, the pressure with downy mildew has been normal so far. The occurrence of aphids and spider mite is minimal due to the weather conditions.
